

Cornwall Photographic Alliance Data Protection Policy 2019

Cornwall Photographic Alliance (CPA) is established with the objects set out in its Constitution, to serve the interests of its associated photographic associations, societies or clubs within the County of Cornwall, and is a data controller within the UK.

The CPA will hold personal information to include name, distinctions, contact details, affiliations, service records, records of entries to events, and such other information as may be necessary for the effective management of the legitimate interests of the CPA and access thereto is restricted to Committee members and to others approved by the committee for specific purposes. The CPA will never share membership information with third parties for marketing (including electronic marketing).

Any person wishing to verify the information held about them by the CPA, or who can correct or update that information may apply to the Secretary.

CPA may retain indefinitely historical archives of (but not limited to) records of work shown at internal and external competitions on its web site or social media; permissions to use images for external competitions; records of meetings, competitions, awards and other event results.
